PUBLIC NOTICE: CALL FOR SPONSORS FOR THE 2022 FESTA DELLA REPUBBLICA, ITALY'S NATIONAL DAY

1. Object of the Sponsorship

The Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco informs that with this public notice begins the process for the selection of sponsors for the preparation of the events linked to the 2022 Festa della Repubblica, Italy's National Day in San Francisco, on June 2, 2022.

We will celebrate Italy's National Day in San Francisco with a reception and a live music concert plus DJset on June 4th, 2022.

Proposals may include financial contributions, technical sponsorships (by providing services or supplying products) or a combination of financial and technical sponsorships.

2. Sponsorship details

In return for the financial contributions or services provided, the Consulate General offers indicatively the following benefits (that will be negotiated case by case in the sponsorship contract):

- Display of sponsor's logo/brand on printed material for the event (such as invitations, fliers, brochures, banners, backdrops);
- Logo on the backdrop behind the stage where the Consul General will deliver his welcome speech;
- Acknowledgment of each supporting entity during Consul general's speech;
- Logo/brand promotion with media;
- Invitations to Italy's National Day (to the reception and concert, depending on the level of sponsorship provided);

3. Sponsorship requirements

Acceptable sponsors are public or private entities, companies, associations, foundations, and other subjects that wish to promote their image, through a collaboration with the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco on the occasion of the celebration of Italy's National Day, in accordance with its institutional scope.

4. Sponsor requirements

- Sponsor shall be deemed compatible with public interests;
- Absence of conflict of interest between the public and private entity (Sponsor);
- Absence of any prejudice or damage to the image of the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco or its initiatives;
- Absence of pending litigation with the Public Administration;
- Legal ability to enter into a contract.

5. Terms and conditions of presentation of sponsorship proposals

Sponsorship proposals shall be sent by email to the Economic and Commercial Affairs office of the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco at commerciale.sanfrancisco@esteri.it, with the following email subject "Sponsorship proposal 2022 Italy's National Day", preferably by April 25, 2022.

- Sponsorship proposals, duly signed, must contain:
 1. Proposing company/association/foundation's legal name and/or fiscal data;
 2. Details of the sponsorship offer (financial contribution or service provided) that is intended to be offered to support this Consulate General during the event;
 3. Statement that acknowledges the acceptance of the sponsorship terms and conditions outlined in this public notice;
 4. Statement that acknowledges the legal ability to enter into a contract with the Public Administration, and that there are no other situations that could limit or preclude the sponsor's contract capacity and that the sponsor does not offer grounds for exclusion from the sponsorship procedure, as set out by art. 80 of Legislative Decree n. 50/2016.

6. Examination of sponsorship proposals

All received sponsorship proposals will be evaluated by a special commission composed of officers of the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco

Sponsorship proposals are not considered binding by the Sponsor for the subsequent formalization of the contract. The Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco, at its sole discretion, reserves the right not to accept proposals that, due to the nature of the sponsorship and/or the Sponsor's activity, are deemed incompatible with the institutional role of this Consulate General. The Sponsor, also, reserves the right to refuse any proposal not compatible with the scope of the initiative.

7. Sponsorship Contract Stipulation

After evaluating all received sponsorship proposals, individual contracts shall be drawn by this Consulate General and the Sponsors selected.

8. Processing of personal data

Pursuant to the Legislative Decree 196/2003 and subsequent amendments and additions, the proponents give their consent to the processing of personal data for the exclusive purpose of administrative and accounting management. The Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco shall be in charge of the processing of personal data.
