To whom it may concern:

Per Italian regulations all Italian citizens must register in Italy any and all changes in their marital status. With regard to the registration of a divorce, Italy requires that a separate document, known as a "Statement of No Appeal," be submitted along with the final judgment of dissolution. The Statement of No appeal declares that the divorce went uncontested and the time to file an appeal has expired.

While this Consulate General understands that this document is not typically issued in the United States, it is nonetheless required by Italian law in order to correctly register a United States divorce in Italy. In an effort to assist our citizens in obtaining this document, we have provided a draft to be completed by the offices of the Court (see page 2 below). It should be prepared on Court letterhead, filled out with the information pertaining to the divorce, and signed by a clerk or other authorized official. Once complete, please return the signed document to the individual requesting it.
