PUBLIC NOTICE: CALL FOR SPONSORS FOR THE SUPPLY OF MADE IN ITALY FURNITURE - BOARDROOM

1. Object of the Sponsorship

The Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco, with this call for sponsors, opens the collection of expressions of interest to sponsor the supply of Made in Italy furniture, to be allocated in the boardroom of the Consulate General, also as part of the ongoing renovations.

The supply will consist in a living room area (including sofas, armchairs, side/coffee tables and desk lamps) for 10 people and a meeting table with 12/14 seats.

Expressions of interest may concern sponsorships with total or partial supply of the aforementioned goods at factory price (without transportation costs).

2. Sponsorship details

In return for the supply, the Consulate General indicatively offers the following services (to be negotiated on a case-by-case basis in the sponsorship contract):

- affixing of the brand/logo on a special wall plaque in the environments covered by the sponsorship
- mention, thanks, and affixing of the brand/logo on communication materials at the inauguration events of the environments covered by the sponsorship and other events to be held there during the year 2024;
- logo/brand disclosure in the communication of the conclusion of the sponsorship contract between the Consulate General and the Sponsor through the Consulate General's IT and social media channels;

3. Sponsorship requirements

All public or private entities, professional firms, companies and businesses that produce furniture in Italy or market Made in Italy products in Italy, the United States of America or other countries, associations, foundations and any other entity that intends to promote its image through collaboration with the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco are eligible to bid for sponsorship.

4. Sponsor requirements

- Sponsor shall be deemed compatible with public interests;
- Absence of conflict of interests between the public and private entity (Sponsor);
- Absence of any prejudice or damage to the image of the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco or its initiatives;
- Absence of pending litigation with the Public Administration;
- Legal ability to enter into a contract.

5. Terms and conditions of presentation of sponsorship proposals

Interested parties should send their expressions of interest to the Commercial Office of the Consulate

The expression of interest, duly signed, must include:

1. the details of the bidder and/or the company name of the company/association/foundation;
2. the indication, even generic or broad, of the asset and/or financial contribution that is intended to be offered to the Consulate General for the purpose of the realization of the event;
3. the declaration that he/she is aware of and accepts the conditions of sponsorship set forth in this notice;
4. the non-existence of conditions of inability to contract with the Public Administration, as well as any other situation considered by law prejudicial or limiting the ability to contract and the 'non-existence of the grounds for exclusion of an economic operator from participation in a tender or concession procedure given by art. 94 Legislative Decree 36/2023.

6. Examination of sponsorship proposals

All received sponsorship proposals will be evaluated by a special commission composed of officers of the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco

Sponsorship proposal are not considered binding by the Sponsee for the subsequent formalization of the contract. The Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco, at its sole discretion, reserves the right not to accept proposals that, due to the nature of the sponsorship and/or the Sponsor's activity, are deemed incompatible with the institutional role of this Consulate General. The Sponsee, also, reserves the right to refuse any proposal not compatible with the scope of the initiative.

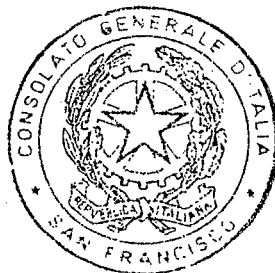
7. Sponsorship Contract Stipulation

After evaluating all received sponsorship proposals, individual contracts shall be drawn by this Consulate General and the Sponsors selected.

8. Processing of personal data

Pursuant to the Legislative Decree 196/2003 and subsequent amendments and additions, the proponents give their consent to the processing of personal data for the exclusive purpose of administrative and accounting management. The Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco shall be in charge of the processing of personal data.
